

Readme for Version 1.1 of the Micro Focus[®] Advanced Authentication Connector for z/OS[®]

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This Readme file contains information you should know before you install or use version 1.1 of the Micro Focus[®] Advanced Authentication Connector for z/OS[®]. Hereafter, this product is referred to by the acronym AACZ in this Readme file.

General Information

Product Description

The Micro Focus Advanced Authentication Connector for z/OS (AACZ) provides a connection between the log-on process that is managed by the IBM[®] System Authorization Facility (SAF) and the external, Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) process provided by the NetIQ Advanced Authentication (AA) Server.

This connection allows the NetIQ AA Server to manage the log-on process for any mainframe applications that interface with SAF, such as TSO, CICS[®], z/OSMF, ChangeMan[®] ZDD, ChangeMan[®] ZMF for Eclipse, and any user applications that require specific log-on authentication.

- NetIQ Advanced Authentication Server version 6.2
- Resource Access Control Facility (RACF®)
- CA ACF2™ version 16
- CA Top Secret® version 16



NOTE If you are using ACF2 or Top Secret, you need to be at version 16 of those products. Contact Computer Associates for any additional required PTFs.
